# Health equity through community affirmation

- **1/3 Native trans** people have postponed medical care, because they were afraid of discrimination.
- 2/3 Native trans people who accessed care in 2014 report experiencing discrimination.
- Trans youth who have socially transitioned have levels of anxiety and depression comparable to their cisgender peers.
- Use of preferred name and pronouns associated with a
   65% decrease in suicide attempts.



# Health equity through community affirmation

If asked, 90% of Two Spirit and LGBTQ individuals would disclose their sexual orientation and gender identity to providers.





### **Sexual Orientation**

• Refers to the way one describes their emotional, romantic, or sexual attraction.

### Gender

 Refers to a person's internal sense of being male, female, both, neither, or something else and the role(s) we play in society.

### Two Spirit

• Refers to an indigenous person who expresses their gender identity, spiritual identity, or social role in a traditional, non-Western way.



### What is gender?

**Gender** refers to a person's internal sense of identity (could be man, woman, both, neither, or another identity) and their social role.

It's like being at the eye doctor when they flip the lenses back and forth. —Is this better? Or this? Comparison and trying different lenses clarifies which works best.



### Definitions

**Cis**: A person whose gender identity corresponds with their sex assigned at birth

**Trans**: A person whose gender identity does not match their sex assigned at birth

**Nonbinary**: A person whose gender identity does not evenly correspond with the male/female binary

**Two Spirit\*** 



### What is Two Spirit?

Refers to an Indigenous person who expresses their gender identity, spiritual identity, or social role in a traditional, non-Western way.

### LGBT HEALTH DISPARITIES

Diamarity

Group	Disparity
LGBT general	Highest rates of increased tobacco, alcohol, and other drug
LGBT Youth	<ul> <li>2 to 3 times more likely to attempt suicide<sup>1</sup></li> <li>More likely to be homeless<sup>1</sup></li> </ul>
Lesbian Women	<ul> <li>Less likely to get preventive services for cancer<sup>1</sup></li> </ul>

**ASK** how clients prefer to be identified-every client, every time.

**Affirm** the good things in your clients' lives by asking about their communities and successes.

### **Acknowledge** the diverse Native concepts of gender and sexual orientation.

**Advocate** for clients who are Two Spirit or LGBTQ.

# NPAIHB Toolkit

#### 9 in 10 patients would disclose their sexual orientation and gender identity to healthcare providers if asked."

#### Ask

Ask clients how they prefer to be identified. Ask everyone. Ask every time.
Develop a relationship to improve trust and offer better care.

#### Affirm

Use preferred names and pronouns. All staff. Every visit.

#### Acknowledge

 There is no universally correct concept of gender identity or sexual orientation.
 Different cultures define gender and sexual orientation in different ways.

#### Advocate

### SUICIDE IN AI/AN TRANSGENDER INDIVIDUALS

### • <u>12 times the rate of lifetime suicide attempt</u>

• 16 times the rate of suicide attempt in the past year

Understanding the scope of the issues and intervening is impeded by

- a lack of uniform data collection
- social rejection and marginalization
- insensitivity to gender identify
- other social/economic factors

### ADDITIONAL BARRIERS FOR TRANSGENDER INDIVIDUALS

### **Family rejection**


- 40% families neutral or not supportive
- 10% experienced violence from family member because transgender

### Violence

- 47% had been sexually assaulted in their lifetime
- 57% not comfortable seeking assistance from police

### **Health Care**

- 23% postponed medical care due to discrimination, 33% due to cost
- 33% had negative experience with provider in past year
- 25% denied coverage for hormonal medications and 55% for surgical transition



Approach a person's health holistically with inclusion of traditional Indigenous medicine.


# Case Study

An 18-year-old individual comes into the clinic. The patient fills out the intake form, indicating that their current gender identity is "female" and their sex assigned at birth is left blank. Their name is Terrence Walker, and they use "they" pronouns.

- How would you address Terrence Walker if you needed to call them to the front desk?
- What steps can you take to ensure Terrence feels welcome in the clinic?
