## Sexual Orientation

Refers to the gender(s) of the people someone is sexually attracted to.
$\square$ Gender
$\square$ Refers to a person's internal sense of being male, female, both, neither, or something else.
Two Spirit
Refers to an indigenous person who expresses their gender identity or spiritual identity in a traditional, non-Western way.



Specific aims:

1) Deliver culturallygrounded resources to youth exploring their gender identity and/or choosing to medically transition
2) Provide resources and support for families
3) Increase health provider awareness of aspects unique to $\mathrm{Al} / \mathrm{AN}$ transgender and Two-Spirit youth
