

Background


- ESSENCE is an emergency department syndromic surveillance data system that:
 - Provides near real-time information on emergency department visits
 - Can be used for early detection of events of public health importance
 - Can be used to measure burden on health care systems during events like the COVID-19 pandemic
- ESSENCE data can **supplement** (but not replace) official case counts, deaths, and lab results reported by states and by IHS
- NWTEC currently has access to ESSENCE data for Oregon and Washington


COVID-19 Emergency Department Indicators by Race Washington State, 12/22/2019 - 4/12/2020, Rates




