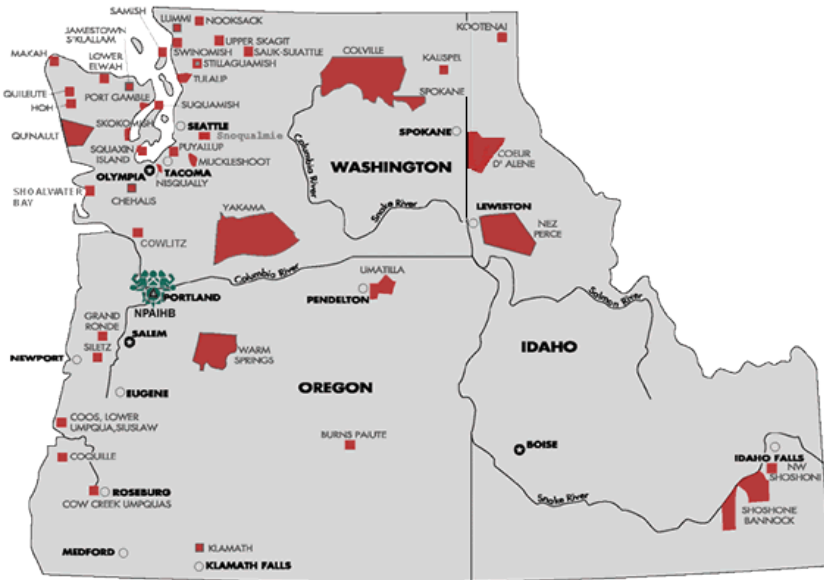


The Real Cost of Commercial Tobacco



Tribal communities have made progress decreasing commercial tobacco use, yet it is still the leading cause of preventable death.

Annual health care cost per state directly caused by smoking

Idaho \$508 Million

Oregon \$1.54 Billion

Washington \$2.81 Billion



Average Cigarette Pack Price

Idaho

\$5.27 a pack X 7 days = \$36.89 a week

\$36.89 X 4 weeks = \$147.56 a month

\$36.89 X 52 weeks = \$1,918.28 a year

Oregon

\$5.75 a pack X 7 days = \$40.25 a week

\$40.25 X 4 weeks = \$161 a month

\$40.25 X 52 weeks = \$2,093 a year

Washington

\$8.29 a pack X 7 days = \$58.03 a week

\$58.03 X 4 weeks = \$232.12 a month

\$58.03 X 52 weeks = \$3,017.56 a year

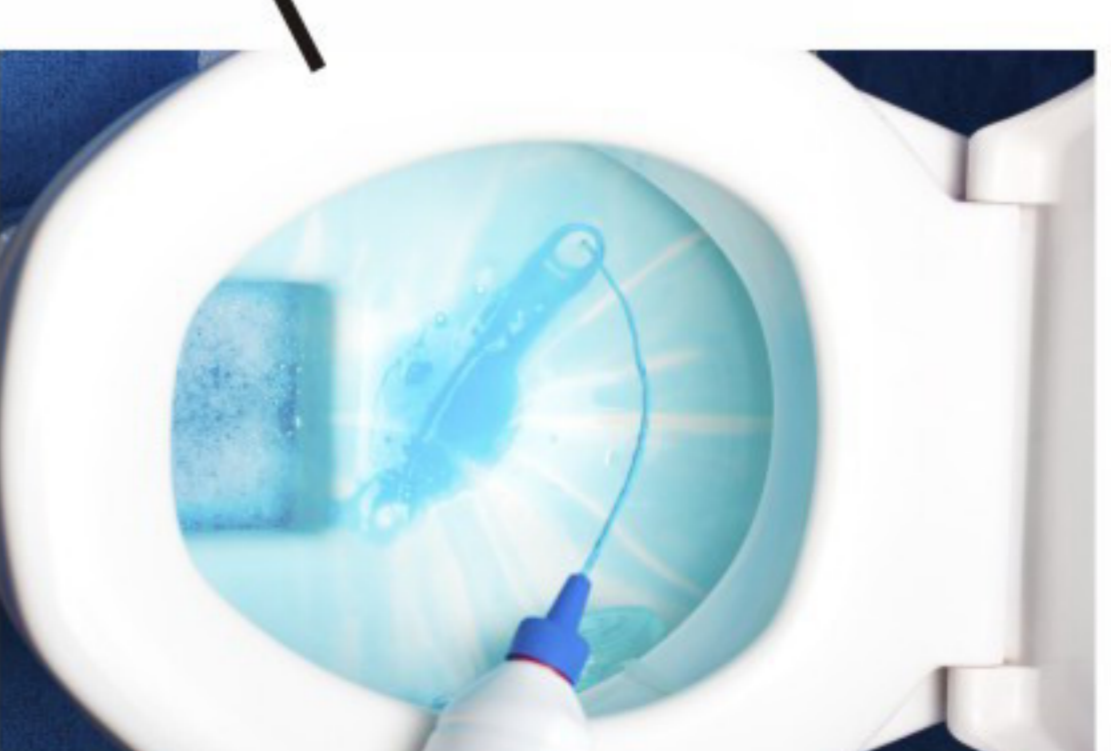

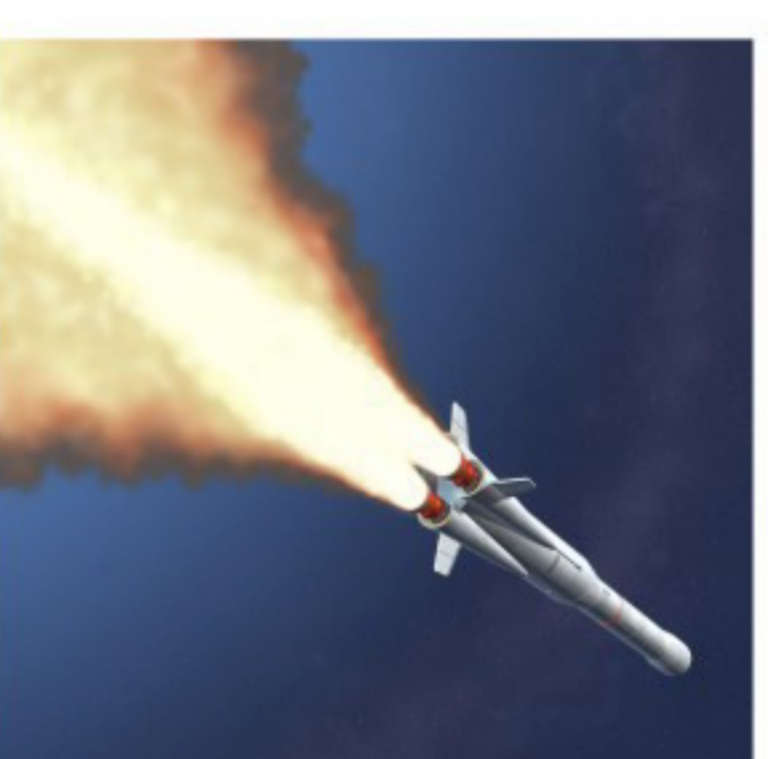
