The CPPO Clinical Pharmacy Boot Camp Library contains a series of recorded presentations covering key topics in Substance Use Disorder (SUD) care aimed at enhancing competency of Clinical Pharmacy Specialists (CPS) Providers with tools and knowledge needed to engage patients while providing high quality, evidence-based care in Alcohol Use Disorder (AUD) and Opioid Use Disorder (OUD). With this library, CPS Providers can review subject case-based topics related to SUD care including foundational principles, risk mitigation and motivational interviewing techniques. CPS Providers continue to be a core member of the interprofessional team offering comprehensive medication management and as the medication expert, they are poised to play a vital role in improving access. 
