
Sharps Bins


- Malheur County has had huge success in our sharps disposal sites
- Design and build process started in 2019, bins were not finished until 2021 (thanks COVID)
- These bins are installed into the ground with cement or drilled into cement.
- 4 Sites throughout the county, 3 different towns

- Locally designed and made in Ontario by Enterprise Sales Welding (specialize in bear traps!)
- Locally wrapped by graphic design and sign company TNT signs (high school friends of peer Cesar)
- Installed by local contractors, a team family member, and the peers themselves.
- Partnerships established with Mallards Grocery (stayed after sale), Valley Family Health Care, City of Nyssa, OFCOI














Collection Data

(we have given out 5,700 syringes this in 2022)

- 2021 Installed Throughout Year
 - 50 Gallons or 15,000 Sharps collected
- 31 Gallons or 9,300 at Mallards location

• 2022 – 5 permanent locations –

-84gallons or 25,200 sharps

Outreach Events

2020-2021

- Started in May 2020
- One a week (give or take with COVID)
- Mallards partners from the start

2021-2022

- May 2021 started going to Vale and Nyssa on Fridays
- August 2021 added Bottle Drop
- October 2021 added Origins
- November 2021 added East Side
- November 2021-November 2022 4 pop up days a week



Outreach by the numbers

2020

- 313 people reached
- 88 Naloxone/Narcan distributed
- 159 safer use kits

2021

- 722 contacts
- 165 Narcan
- 208 safer use kits

2022

- 1602 people reached
- 568 Narcan distributed
- 394 safer use kits

Try to hand out Narcan to everyone getting a kit, some people get kits more often and have Narcan on stock
