CF

- **Screening**
- **Interview/survey/assessment**

Case Management

CM

- **Make or receive referral**
- **Assist with filling out forms**

Health Education

HE

- **Preparing**
- **Planning**
- **Presenting**

Interpret/Translate

IT

- Orally or in writing
- Translating from one language to another
- Clarifying medical instructions
- Clarifying and or reading documents such as mail, applications, etc....

Monitor Patient

MP

- **Monitor how pt is feeling**
 - Subjective**
 - Objective**

Patient Care

PC

- **Providing emotional support**
- **Delivering meds, supplies, equipment**

Other Patient Services

OP

- Any pt centered service not included in other service code
- Planning, coordinating, conducting specialty clinic or event
- Prep work for clinic or event
- Clean up after clinic or event

TP

- **Transport according to tribal policy**
